Dr. Richard Call graduated from Washington University, School of Dental Medicine in 1975 and has been practicing General Dentistry in Thornton, Colorado for over 33 years. Concerned with access to care issues, he completed a Masters Degree from the University of Colorado, School of Medicine Health Administration Program in 1977. He served on the full-time faculty of the CU School of Dental Medicine for over 20 years through 1996, developing a number of programs to improve access to care including the nationally recognized ACTS Program (Advanced Clinical Training and Service Program) and serving as Chairman of the Department of Applied Dentistry, Director of an AEGD Program, Director of the eight-state Mountain-Plains AIDS Education and Training Center, and Director of the Colorado Area Health Education Center. He has headed research and training programs totaling more than \$20 million in grants, and has authored numerous publications, articles, abstracts, and scientific and continuing education presentations on dental issues in special populations including the aged, HIV/AIDS populations, migrant workers, and on dental insurance, practice management and ethics. He continues to teach part-time and is a member of the ADA, CDA, MDDS, and is a Fellow in the International College of Dentists and the Pierre Fauchard Academy. He is active in international humanitarian dental projects, serves as a consultant to the Colorado State Board of Dental Examiners and is a member of the Board of Trustees of Delta Dental of Colorado.
